Spiritual Healing and a Plant-based Life

"I come that they might have life and have it abundantly." – Jesus (John 10:10)

All world religions believe that healing begins in first "calling forth" (affirming) the very life of God-Spirit and then all else will follow. God is the source of life.

According to author and speaker Rona Cherry, "sacred texts from ancient traditions are unexpected manuals for contemporary healing. They generally offer an holistic approach to well-being that encompasses physical, mental and spiritual health — a perspective increasingly valued in our fast-paced world."

Some of you know that I am a pescatarian (not a Presbyterian). Decades ago, based upon nonviolence and a respect for all life as sacred, I adopted a vegetarian diet that foregoes consumption of meat and fowl. Eastern religions advocate "Ahimsa" (nonviolence) that is extended even into their dietary choices.

Our Christian Bible presents a plant-based diet as part of God's plan, suggesting a menu of mostly fruit, vegetables and grains. However, the Bible also mentions meat consumption.

We must use our own understanding and wisdom as God-Mind guides us. Jesus turned water into wine; perhaps Moscato is sacred!

Seriously, it is wise to note that current research shows the benefit of plant-based diets in reducing risks of chronic disease and promoting better overall health.

A recent study published by the Journal of the American Heart Association found that "higher consumption of plant-based foods was associated with a lower risk of cardiovascular disease and all-cause mortality," now confirming ancient wisdom.




The Prayer for Protection
